Questions to Ponder:

- 1. What was your response to what you heard?
- 2. Think of a time you were made to feel welcome. What in particular made you feel welcome? What did you feel in that moment?
- 3. "The unconditional love of God" what does that look like?
- 4. Patrice says that helping people, especially people seeking refuge, is not an option and is scattered throughout scripture. How do you respond? Patrice asks, "Do my actions meet this call?"
- 5. Hava shares her story about living in Afghanistan and then coming to Australia. What significant points stood out to you about Hava's story?
- 6. The House of Welcome provides a safe and welcoming space for people seeking asylum and refugees living in the community. What impacted you about the work and stories from the team at the House of Welcome?
- 7. What are the ways you already 'Welcome the Stranger' personally or as a community?
- 8. What has challenged you about what was shared?
- 9. What difference, if any, has this presentation made to the way you will move forward in welcoming the stranger?
