Aoife McGrath, Director of Pastoral Theology at the Pontifical University, St Patrick's College, Maynooth, Ireland, introduces us to the foundations of Lay Pastoral Ministry.

About the Presenter:

Aoife McGrath has a Doctorate in Moral Theology from the Pontifical University, Maynooth and an MA in Chaplaincy Studies and Pastoral Work from Mater Dei Institute of Education, Dublin City University. She has worked as a Parish Pastoral Worker in the Diocese of Waterford and Lismore.

She conducted research for the Catholic Education Service (of the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference) on Catholic Tertiary Education, producing a Report on the Catholic Higher Education Landscape in Ireland (April 2013) and another entitled The Future of Catholic Third Level Education in Ireland: Models, Clustering, & Theology in the Academy (February 2014).

She worked as a Research Assistant with the Pastoral Research Office of the Australian Catholic Bishops' Conference, Melbourne (2014), working on the project Priests in Australia 1950-2010, which was commissioned by The Truth Justice and Healing Council.

She was employed as a Project Officer with the Christian Research Association, Melbourne (2015) to undertake research Exploring Lay Pastoral Ministry in the Catholic Church in Australia (January 2016), which was commissioned by the Australian Catholic Bishop's Conference.

On the basis of that research, she was invited by the Australian Catholic Council for Lay Pastoral Ministry to be involved in the drafting of a national guidelines document, Faithful Stewards of God's Grace, which was launched during Proclaim 2018.

After returning to Ireland, Aoife worked as a lecturer in Pastoral Theology, and Academic and Pastoral Support Coordinator, at the Pontifical University, Maynooth. She was appointed to the position of Director of Pastoral Theology in September 2019.

In November 2018, she participated in the Weaving Theology in Oceania: Culture, Context and Practice conference, which took place in Fiji and was organized by the Association for Practical Theology in Oceania (APTO). The papers from that conference are now published in a book of the
